


Ring Ready and Rally Steady


Thank you for your enthusiastic feedback about the new format for the Barker Newsletter! It is a pleasure to create this for all of you each month.

Xylitol can be listed on labels as Birch Sugar, Wood Sugar or Birch **Bark Sugar.**

Extreme Toxicity to Dogs: Xylitol/birch sugar is highly toxic and potentially fatal to dogs. Even small amounts can trigger a rapid release of insulin, leading to a dangerous drop in blood sugar (hypoglycemia), liver failure, seizures, or death. It is crucial to keep all products containing xylitol/birch sugar out of reach of pets.
